

Cwmni Egino is seeking expressions of interest to participate in Market Engagement. We are keen to engage with technology providers – or companies which are aligned to a technology provider – as well as developers, client/licensee organisations, and potential funders who share our vision of being the first small scale nuclear development in the UK.





About Cwmni Egino

Cwmni Egino was established by the Welsh Government in 2021 to create sustainable job opportunities and promote economic and social regeneration by driving future development at the former nuclear power station site in Trawsfynydd. Our vision is for Trawsfynydd to be the site of the first small scale nuclear generation in the UK, with a target of being under construction by 2027 (the 'Project').

We have set a 3-phase programme to deliver our vision:

- 1. define the overall business proposition for small scale nuclear generation at Trawsfynydd and demonstrate it is feasible and can be delivered;
- 2. initial project development, including site characterization and environmental studies, engineering development and preparation of permit applications; and
- submission of permit applications, procurement, revenue contract development and financing.

Our primary strategic objective is to be one of the new nuclear generation projects selected for deployment in the next Parliament (2024-2029). In order to achieve this, we plan to complete Phase 1 and be ready to start Phase 2 by the end March 2023.





Market Engagement

We are undertaking Market Engagement with interested parties to identify potential solutions that meet our vision, define our requirements, and support a viable business proposition for the Project. This will enable the Project to progress to the second phase of development, and also inform any future procurement strategy.

We are currently developing a full questionnaire to support Market Engagement. Topic areas of specific interest are likely to include (but are not limited to) the following:

- Technology Readiness, including the status of design and licensing
- Delivery Model, including key delivery partners
- Proposed role(s) in Target Operating model for Trawsfynydd and previous experience in those roles
- Socio-economic benefits, including supply chain development and workforce development
- Funding plan to underpin design development and licensing
- Ability to attract investment for small scale nuclear deployment at Trawsfynydd
- Ability to achieve a Final Investment Decision and commence construction by 2027
