

Returning for its second edition, the Nuclear Industry Association will host its flagship Advanced Nuclear Technologies (ANT26) conference on Wednesday 17 June 2026 at the Rum Warehouse, in Liverpool.

At a pivotal moment for advanced nuclear in the UK and globally, ANT26 will bring together industry leaders, innovators, policymakers and investors from across the advanced nuclear ecosystem to exchange ideas, build partnerships and showcase innovation.

The conference will explore the latest developments in Small Modular Reactors and Advanced Modular Reactors. 

## Payment
