Overview of our workstreams



Pipeline, Data & Insights Enable sector-wide collaboration through a shared pipeline, underpinned by standardised data, to generate actionable insights and drive informed decision-making and performance improvement



Supplier Development To adopt a standardised nuclear (civil & defence) cross-industry supplier baseline assessment tool. This is to set consistent standards and expectations across nuclear industry for existing and new suppliers – and our intention is to have a free self-assessment



Pre-Qualification Achieve a standardised cross-industry prequalification question set & sharing of answers/supporting information on a common platform.



Supplier Audit Ongoing industry-wide collaboration on planned audits with aligned expectations, standards, processes and delivery to drive right first-time quality across the supply chain and reduce duplication and burden on resource.

Co-ordinated, collaborative programme

Consolidated 10 year view of civil and defence nuclear pipeline activities; industry and public-facing insights; supplier dashboards.

Pre-contract (tendering) phase

1. Standardised question set including:
Nuclear specific question set

2. Option to answer question set once and avoid having to fill out every PSQ.

Co-ordinated audit and inspections between Licensees

Supplier Development

Supplier self-assessment (free) or targeted assessment. Can be used pre- and post-contract to drive continuous improvement and best practice.

Cross-industry collaboration

SCCP aims to drive **harmonisation**, **standardisation** and **simplification** across the UK Nuclear sector and supply chain.

To do this, we have set up a clear governance model and engaged Licensees at both senior and working level.
